2010 Municipal Election

Vote by Mail information

There will be a new method of voting in the 2010 Township of South-West Oxford's municipal election – ***Vote by Mail!*** This method used by many municipalities is known to increase voter turnout from the 30-35 percent range to approximately 50-55 percent range.

Vote by Mail is very user friendly, flexible and convenient. The voter kits are mailed out three weeks prior to the election. Voters mail their ballots back in a pre-paid postage envelope or they may drop it in a secure ballot box at the Township office during regular business hours (9:00-5:00 p.m.) This method is convenient for those voters with disabilities as it allow the voter to complete their ballot from their own home with the assistance of their own devices.

Voting Day for the 2010 Municipal Election has been changed to the fourth Monday in October – **Monday, October 25, 2010**. This is as a result of the passing of Bill 212, The Good Government Act, which received Royal Assent on December 15th, 2009.
