2018 DOG LICENSE APPLICATION FORM

Please bring completed form to the Township Office or mail along with a cheque payable to the Township of South-West Oxford.

Committed to being a leader in the development and delivery of municipal services for the growth and well-being of the community and dedicated to providing a safe community for all residents and their pets, the Township of South-West Oxford requires all dog owners to license their dog(s), pursuant to By-Law No. 76-2017.

Subject to By-Law No. 76-2017, licensing fees shall be paid to the Township within 14 days of acquiring the dog(s):

- \$20.00 for the first male or female dog; and
- \$30.00 for each additional male or female dog on the property, regardless of ownership

Tags should be purchased at the beginning of the year and the price will increase by \$5.00 each after April 30th, 2017. Licensing your animal and ensuring that your pet always wears its tag can help your pet be returned to you in cases where your dog is lost.

To avoid receiving a fine, dogs must be prohibited from running at large. Purchasing a license does not protect the owner or person reclaiming a dog against fees incurred for pick-up and care of the dog. Failure to purchase a license may result in a fine under the Provincial Offences Act.
