- ✓ Hand cream bottles
- ✓ Hand soap bottles

- ✓ Margarine & yogurt containers (tubs & lids (#5)
- ✓ Metal food & beverage cans

The Following Items **ARE NOT** Recyclable

“What Stays OUT”

Cardboard Items:

- X Waxed cardboard
- X Coffee cups

Glass/Plastic Items:

- X Blister wrap
- X Brake fluid containers
- X Bubble packaging
- X Flow pots & trays, even if there is a #5 on the bottom
- X Foil/plastic multi-layered bags
- X Herbicide bottles
- X Light bulbs
- X Mirror glass
- X Plastic drinking cups
- X Plastic prescription pill jars
- X Saran wrap
- X Straws
- X Window glass
- X Styrofoam packaging material
- X Plastic water softener bags
- X Boxboard product inner liners (wax paper) – cereal & cracker box liners
- X Broken glass
- X Corrosive material bottles
- X Fluorescent tubes & compact fluorescent light bulbs
- X Glass drinking cups
- X Inner milk pouches
- X Motor oil containers
- X Pesticide bottles
- X Plastic egg cartons – if they are not a #6
- X Plastic toys
- X Stiff/crinkly type bags (potato chip)
- X Transmission fluid containers
- X Windows
- X Styrofoam meat trays/cups

Metal Items:

- X Batteries
- X Metal that is NOT an empty food or beverage container

Paper Items:

- X Carbon paper
- X Diapers
- X Facial tissue (Kleenex, etc)
- X Paper drinking cups
- X Wax coated cups like coffee cups
- X Construction paper
- X Hard covers on books
- X Kraft paper
- X Paper towels
- X Waxed paper

Other Items:

- X Crockery (kitchen dishes, coffee mugs)
- X Motor oil
- X Syringes
- X Mason jars
- X String
- X wood
