Garbage and recycling will now be collected on “Red” days

Starting the week of **September 13, 2021**, we are adjusting collection routes help make the best use of collector time. The following residences currently picked up on “Yellow” days will be moved to “Red” days:

- All of Daniel Road
- Prouse Road between Dereham Line and Zenda Line
- Zenda Line between Prouse Road and Daniel Road

If you are a property owner receiving this message, please share it with tenants or residents living in the affected property.

Collection dates during route adjustment

2021	Yellow dates	Red dates
August	3, 11, 19, 27	---
September	7	14, 22, 30

Curbside collection reminders

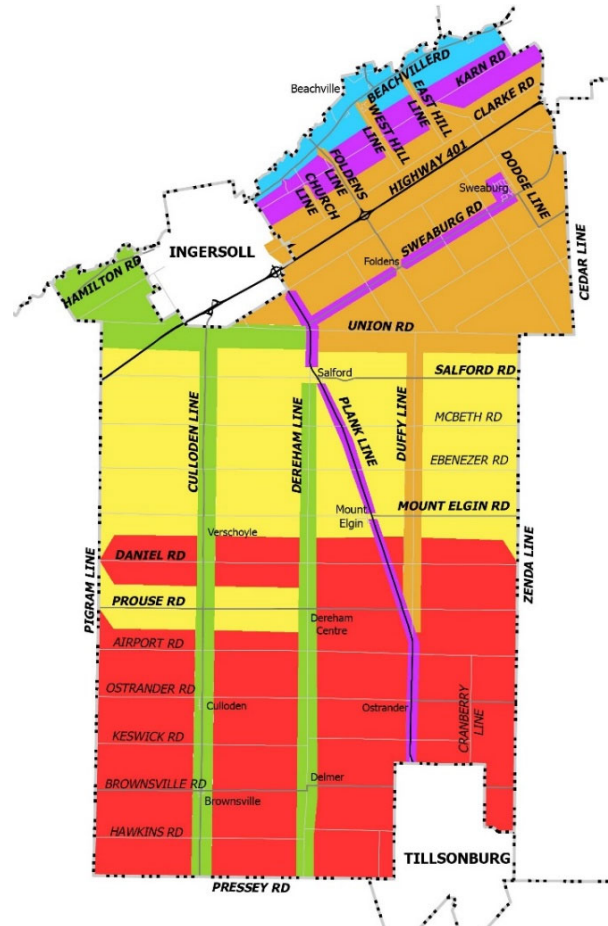
- Set out at the curb no later than 7:00 a.m. on your collection day.
- Place no further than 1 metre from municipal curb.

Recycling

- Recyclables must be loose in recycling boxes.
- Recyclables must be rinsed and cleaned. Contaminated recycling will not be collected.
- Only use plastic bags for shredded paper.
- Cardboard must be flattened and bundled no larger than 75 cm x 75 cm x 20 cm.

Garbage

- Garbage bags must not be broken or ripped.
- Garbage must not weigh more than 20 kg (44 lbs).
- One bag tag is needed for each bag/container. For containers, place the tag inside on the top bag. Both ends of the bag tag must be visible and placed on the bag, not containers.
