Road Resurfacing on Oxford Road 46 (Salford Road) and Quinn Drive

Oxford Road 46 (Salford Road), between Highway 19 and 390m east of the village limits, and Quinn Drive will be closed for road resurfacing in the Township of South-West Oxford

Oxford County has awarded a contract to GIP Paving of Petersburg, Ontario, for road resurfacing on Oxford Road 46 (Salford Road), between Highway 19 and 390m east of the village limits, and Quinn Drive in the Township of South-West Oxford. The work includes full depth asphalt removals, maintenance hole and catch basin adjustments, hot mix asphalt replacement and new pavement markings.

Road work is tentatively scheduled to begin in June and is expected to be completed by the end of July 2025. Please note that construction schedules are weather dependent and subject to change based on contractor availability and other operational demands.

How will the project impact me?

Traffic control

During construction, Oxford Road 46 will be closed to through traffic. Traffic will be limited to local residents, businesses and emergency services. The contractor will be required to maintain access as best as possible to all properties. Some short-term interruptions and delays can be expected during this work.

Emergency services and buses will be notified of all road closures and lane restrictions. There will be a planned detour route in place for the duration of the road closure including applicable detour signage.


Detour: Highway 19/Plank Line, Union Road, Duffy Line and Oxford Road 46

Garbage and Recycling

There should be no impact to regular household waste and recyclable collection. If access for waste collection is interrupted by construction, the contractor will collect homeowner bins and containers and take them to a central location for collection. Property owners are asked to mark garbage and recycling containers with their house number so they can be returned to the correct property. Please continue to have your regular household waste and recyclables on the roadside by 7:00 a.m. on your regular pick-up day.
