

Council Highlights – January 6, 2026

This meeting took place the Township of South-West Oxford's Municipal office at 9:00 a.m. A summary of the happenings from Council is as follows:

- **Safe and Well Oxford Plan Update:** Sarah Hamulecki and Warden Marcus Ryan presented the updated Community Safety Well Being Plan legislated through the *Community Safety and Policing Act, 2019*. Council approved the updated plan and endorsed Oxford County as the lead for implementation of the Safe and Well Oxford Plan.
- **Court of Revision – Whaley Drain Branch 'A':** Court of Revision was held for the Whaley Drain Branch 'A' and the Provisional By-law was read for a third time and finally adopted.
- **GrantMatch – Government Funding Identification and Application Support:** Council authorized the CAO to execute an agreement with GrantMatch Corp., to assist the Township in identifying and applying for government funding opportunities. Gibson Ingram from GrantMatch was present and responded to questions from Council on how GrantMatch assists municipalities in successful grant applications.
