This meeting took place the Township of South-West Oxford's Municipal office at 6:30 p.m. A summary of the happenings from Council is as follows:

- Oxford County Growth Forecasts and Land Needs: Meghan House, Oxford County Planning and Jamie Cook and Bradley Post from Watson & Associates Economists Ltd., made a presentation to Council regarding the County Growth Forecasts and Land Needs.
- Application for Official Plan Amendment (OP25-05-4) and Zone Change (ZN4-25-03): A Public Meeting was held for Official Plan Amendment (OP25-05-4) and Zone Change (ZN4-25-03) submitted by MHBC Planning on behalf of S.A.M.I. Holdings Ltd., for property located at 545021 Clarke Road. Council supported the application for Official Plan Amendment and approved-in-principle the Zone Change application pending Site Plan Approval.
- SCOR Economic Development Corporation: Council received an update presentation from Kimberly Earls, Executive Director and Ed Ketchabaw, Chair of the South Central Ontario Region Economic Development Corporation (SCOR EDC).
